Tips & Tricks

By default, **when you open the clock of a historicized field**, you can read a summary of the various changes made to this field.

For example, you can see that the teacher below was first permanent in the 2020 school year, then temporary in the 2024 school year. This information helps you understand how your reports are completed.

This default tab can be modified, if you'd rather see the details of changes when you open the history:

you'll then see the precise date on which the field value was modified, how/by whom it was modified, and you can duplicate/edit or even delete this modification as required.

To do this, go to your screen rules: from the Other > Administration > Screen rules menu. In dlghisto's custom screen rules, add these lines:

```
if (phase=='onInit') {
self.getFellow("histos_tabbox").setSelectedTab(self.getFellow("histos_tab_details"));
}
```

This allows you to select the default Tab histos_tab_details when entering the dlghisto screen.
